FAQs:

- DSAPs are worth 17.5 hours for the 2016-2017 school year. (See attached calendar)
- DSAPs from the 2015-2016 school year may be extended with administrative approval.
- Professional employees must submit their 2016-2017 DSAP to their supervising administrator no later than June 3, 2016.
- Principals must approve DSAPs two weeks after employee submission, but no later than June 17, 2016.

DISTRICT MANDATED DSAPS

- All ENCORE or Special Area Subjects (K-12) will participate in District mandated DSAPs for the 2016-2017 school year.
 - Content Areas Include: Art, Business Computer and Informational Technology (BCIT), Family and Consumer Science, Health and Physical Education, Music (General Choral and Instrumental), Industrial Technology, Library/Media.
 - Staff will have a choice to fulfil their 17.5 hours during the summer or on the Flexible Professional Learning Days that occur throughout the 2016-2017 school year.

DSAP TIMELINE:

- 6/3/2016 Professional employees must submit their DSAP
- 6/17/2016 Administrators must have all DSAPs approved
Extensions will be granted for extenuating circumstances (checker boarding, etc.)
- 12/22/2016 DSAP hours must be completed (unless District Mandated DSAP)
- 1/20/2017 Mid-Year Progress Update must be completed and submitted via PA-EETEP
- 3/31/2017 DSAP Implementation must be completed (unless District Mandated DSAP)
- 4/28/2017 Year-End Progress Update must be completed and submitted via PA-EETEP

SLO TIMELINES:

- 3/31/17 SLOs must be completed
- 4/28/2017 SLO Data Overall Summary and Summary Sheets must be completed
